The first application thrips, mites, should be made approximately 2 weeks after the leafminers pinch, when new shoots are about 1.5 in. (4 cm) in length. Then spray once a week for about 3 weeks. Paclobutrazol drench at 1 to 2 ppm has also shown to

be effective.
