Comments:

Avoid stretch by moving crop to cooler air temperature in second and third weeks of propagation. Transplant on time.

Cool temperatures and high light will reduce or eliminate any need for PGRs. Monitor regularly for high pH and possible iron deficiency. Flowering will be best as days lengthen in late Spring and Summer. Daylength of more than 14 hours will hasten flowering.
