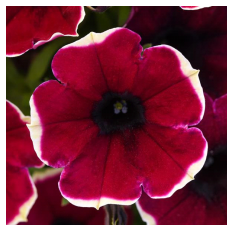

Paclobutrazol(D) 0.25-1.0 ppm applied as crop matures will control final height but not delay flowering or reduce flower size. | Pests: Whitefly, 2-thrips, leafminers | Diseases: Botrytis, Root rot, Tobacco Mosaic Virus | Comments: Cool temperatures and high light will reduce the need for PGRs. Monitor regularly for high pH and possible iron deficiency. |

Crop Time

4- to 5-inch (10- to 13-cm) Pots, Quarts :6-inch (15-cm) Pots, Gallons:10- to 12-inch (25- to 30-cm) Tubs or Baskets:
1 ppp, 5-7 weeks 2-3 ppp, 6-8 weeks 3-5 ppp, 8-11 weeks
