Best-performing lineup of solid colors and bicolors with early flowering. Most flower with a 10.5-hour day length. Stays open and in flower under low light. Early flowering; target production weeks prior to Week 5 (South) and Week 14 (North). Works well in 4.5 to 6-in. (11 to 15-cm) pots up to large baskets.

A new color addition that shows the most distinct true orange color in the greenhouse; shows more pink outside.

Avoid saturated media and excessive feed levels.
